Best practice -1

Village Adoption (An Institutional Social Responsibility initiative)

Objective:

Context:

It will give an opportunity to the students to experience the reality of life and to help the needy people around them. Various development programmes undertaken by our teachers and students will ensure a better life of the villagers.

Practice:

The college through NSS unit has executed the village adoption as one of the best practices. The college has organized week-long awareness camp in Naharpukhuri village on social issues and environmental problems, meeting basic needs of life such as sanitation, pure drinking water and small family norms as well as developing their livelihood skills. The college tries to advocate promotion of livelihood opportunities for the villagers. To motivate the villagers in acquiring entrepreneurship development on different livelihood avenues the teachers have

delivered motivational speeches in this regards. The college has initiated to assist the villagers on ensuring universal and equal access to educational facilities. Free medical camp and blood donation camp arranged by the institution in the village.

Evidence of success:

The students become enthusiastic and interested in participating not only on activities of adopted village but also on any situation they do not hesitate a little bit to offer their helping hand. The village adoption programme has improved the awareness about the need of social responsibility.

Problems encountered:

- Participation of large number of students in different environment related programmes is appreciable.
- Organic manure is produced and income is generated by vermi composting
- The college is awarded by Green Certificate.

Problems encountered:

- It is a tedious task in banning plastic completely in campus.
- Recycling of non-degradable waste material is very expensive and time consuming

Resources Required:
